## Minutes from the February Meeting

**C**HAPTER President Dave Schmidt called the meeting to order at 8:06. About a dozen members and one visitor were present. Dave informed the members that about two weeks ago, Tom Babbin suffered a brain aneurism and was in the hospital for about two weeks. As of the meeting date, he has been transferred to a long-term care facility in Natick, and it is expected that he will be there for some time. Dave said that we'd gotten a letter from the organizers of New Jersey's MosquitoCon and from Southern Maine, both asking for a trophy package. John Touloupis noted that for many years the club strategy was to buy trophy packs from clubs that were likely to buy from us at Patcon, but this is no longer valid as we haven't done a Patcon in years. There was some discussion, and it was noted that Patriot Chapter may resume Patcon in the future and it would be good to have some good will built up with other clubs. Following discussion there was a motion to buy a trophy pack from Southern Maine. The motion was seconded and passed by majority vote.

The year-end group build was brought up again. Bill Michaels said that after last month's meeting, several members commented that they wished the "Double Play" had been left in as a possible category. The members discussed this for a short time and agreed that

"Double Play" should be added to the four options from last month. There were three rounds of voting, and in the end the result was a series of ties. The members agreed that there were be two themes this year: "Double Play" and "100 Years of Naval Aviation."

Dave stressed the need for all club members to pay their 2011 dues. At this time only about half the members have done so.

Bill reminded the club that the June meeting is "Group Build Amnesty Month," where members can bring in subjects that were not finished in time for previous years' group builds.

This ended the business portion of the meeting, and Dave immediately moved to Show and Tell. Only two models were on display. Following Show and Tell, there was a brief break followed by the raffle. After the raffle, the meeting broke up for the night. Some members stayed for a game of Wings of War.
